



Prestigious ACI SAFE DRIVING COURSE for Sri Lankans



ACI (Italian Automobile Association) in partnership with the Embassy of Sri Lanka has, Rome, has launched an initiative to offer a SAFE DRIVING COURSE highly recognized in Italy for Sri Lankan nationals who hold valid Italian driving licenses. This programme will be offered on a very limited basis to eligible driving license holders free of charge which otherwise is provided at a substantial fee.



FOR WHOM: Sri Lankans who hold Italian driving licenses. Numbers are LIMITED

WHAT: theoretical and practical aspects of safe driving. Dealing with basic principles of safe driving and how to deal with emergencies - Snow, rain storms, road side emergencies etc. It will only be a programme for practical training and not for scrutiny or to ascertain different competences.

WHEN: selected weekends

DURATION: one day(Saturday/Sunday)

WHERE: Rome - ACI's specialized facility:: Autodromo di Vallelunga, Via Mola Maggiorana, 4/6 - 00063 Campagnano di Roma, Province of Rome.

COST: FREE OF CHARGE for Sri Lankans (normally around €400.)

LANGUAGE: Italian

TRANSPORT: ACI will provide complementary transport from Termini station to Vallelunga facility and return to Termini station after the course
